

He is a member of numerous professional organizations, including the American Dental Association, American Academy of Periodontology, Michigan Dental Association, Michigan Periodontal Alumni, International Team of Implantology, Academy of Osseointegration, Midwest Periodontal Society and a member of the Omicron Kappa Upsilon Honorary Dental Society. He is also committed to the education of future dentists and was an Adjunct Clinical Assistant Professor at University of Michigan for 28 year and is currently a member of the Dean's Faculty.
