

The Michigan Dental Association in conjunction with Genesee District Dental Society bring this live webinar to Michigan's local dental societies.

This webinar is a collaborative effort featuring Dr. Macksood Aftab, chair of the Department of Radiology at Ascension Genesys Hospital, and Dr. Julianna Hukill, a private practice oral surgeon in Grand Blanc. Together they will share their knowledge and clinical expertise in their respective areas. Ample time will be saved for Q&A at the conclusion of the presentations.
